- Get involved in the discovery phase: joining problem-statement workshops, helping gather the data and user research that frames a problem, and seeing how a feature goes from a question to a decision.
- Work on AI-powered features alongside our Data Science/AI team, one of the most interesting and fast-moving parts of our product.
